The government allows funding that exceeds your billable charges in the event the family needs assistance with books, transportation and personal expenses (i.e. laundry, entertainment, etc).

As you are evaluating your financial aid package, here are some important facts for you to consider:

- “Scholarships” and “grants” are gift aid, not requiring repayment.
- There are terms and conditions for the renewal of scholarships and grants you have been offered.
- SAP: Satisfactory Academic Progress is reviewed every semester.
- The hours of employment you are offered through work-study programs are limited.
- Student loans and parent loans are optional and are at the family’s discretion.
- If you assume student loans, it is important to understand the terms and conditions of the loans you borrow.
