

## **Voice Audition Requirements**

### **Bachelor of Music, the Bachelor of Music Education and the Bachelor of Arts**

Applicants interested in majoring in the Bachelor of Music in Vocal Performance:

- Applicants must be prepared to sing three classical or art songs: one must be in English, one must be an early Italian piece (Example: a selection from the 24 Italian Songs and Arias of the 17th and 18th Centuries), and one selection of the applicant's choice.
- Sight read your vocal part from a choral piece which will be accompanied.
- Request a letter of recommendation from your choral or private voice teacher. The recommendation should be sent directly to the School of Music so that it will be on file before your audition date.

Applicants interested in majoring in the Bachelor of Music Education or the Bachelor of Arts in Music:

- Applicants must be prepared to sing two contrasting classical or art songs. One selection must be in English.
- Sight read your vocal part from a choral piece which will be accompanied.
- Request a letter of recommendation from your choral or private voice teacher. The recommendation should be sent directly to the School of Music so that it will be on file before your audition date.

An accompanist will be provided for your audition. In choosing songs, please choose songs from any Italian song collection or from the approved state contest solo material. If you are unsure of your selection, please call a member of the vocal faculty.
