The U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service requires that you file a statement with the university that shows adequate financial support for your education. You must submit the enclosed University of Tulsa Confirmation of Financial Resources form to the TU Office of International Student Services. This form must be signed by you and your sponsor, and countersigned and sealed by the sponsor's bank. Such seals and signatures must be in original ink, not photocopies. Bank deposit slips or balance statements are not acceptable.

There is only one exception to the use of this form. If you are sponsored by a government or agency, such sponsors must provide an official letter with an original signature clearly indicating that financial support will cover all university costs and personal living expenses. If such sponsorship does not cover all costs, additional evidence of funding for uncovered expenses is required, as indicated above. Be certain to check the estimated annual expenses on the attached enclosure. These figures are subject to change.

Documented evidence of financial support must bear a date not older than one year prior to the desired dates of attendance. Such documentation must be received before your final status is determined. After you are admitted, an I-20 or DS-2019 will be issued by the TU International Student Services Office.

If you are admitted to the university, do not attend, and later wish to update your status, a new financial statement must be provided. It is your responsibility to do this well in advance of your desired attendance.

- Complete official records of all academic work must be sent directly to this office from the issuing institution or agency. You must submit an official copy of the original document, in your language, and certified English translations of all secondary and university work, as well as a syllabus of university work if you wish to receive transfer credit. If you have completed sixty (60) hours at a U.S. institution at the time of application, secondary transcripts need not be submitted.
- Test scores (TOEFL) sent directly from Educational Testing Service to the TU Office of International Student Services. (TU institutional code: 6883).
- A photocopy of personal data page of passport.
- We strongly encourage students to provide a student essay (common application essay, or topic of your choice) and counselor or teacher recommendation letters, and SAT/ACT tests where applicable.
- Completed and signed official confirmation of financial resources statement (to include all dependents, if applicable).
- All materials submitted with the application become the property of The University of Tulsa and cannot be returned.

Certification:

I certify that all information supplied by me in connection with my application for admission is complete and accurate. The giving of false information or withholding of required information will, at the option of the university, void and terminate my enrollment.
