APPLICANTS INTENDING TO MAJOR IN MUSIC WITH VOICE AS PRIMARY INSTRUMENT

Have <u>three</u> memorized selections prepared for the audition (solo art songs or aria). One selection should be in a language other than English. Piano accompanist will be provided or you may bring your own.

Bring one copy of a repertoire list which includes all solo literature studied by the student to be presented to the evaluators at the time of the audition.

Request a letter of recommendation from choral or private voice teacher to be sent directly to the School of Music, 800 S. Tucker Drive, Tulsa, OK 74104 so it will be on file before audition.

Complete <u>Vocal Audition and Grant-In-Aid Form</u>, available electronically from Prof. Goldman-Moore, and send, email, or fax to School of Music so it is on file before audition.

Have <u>two</u> memorized selections prepared for audition (solo art songs or aria). Piano accompanist will be provided or you may bring your own.
