Students applying for financial assistance for the 2009-2010 academic year at The University of Tulsa should **read this form completely and follow the directions. Priority deadline for best financial aid consideration is April 1, 2009.**

## SCHOLARSHIPS

Undergraduate applicants who want to be considered for **University Scholarships** do **not** need to file a financial aid application if they do not want to be considered for the need-based financial aid programs listed above. The Office of Admissions will review all applicants' records (GPA, class rank, academic units, test scores, and an interview) to determine recipients. No special application is required, only a completed admission application. Students interested in The University of Tulsa **Performing Arts Scholarships** or **Athletic Scholarships** should contact those departments or coaches directly for requirements (such as auditions, etc.) for award consideration. When the Student Financial Services Office is notified of a student's selection for these awards, a notice will be sent.

Scholarships will be reevaluated each spring and possibly revoked if the grade point requirement is not achieved. Consideration for the renewal of a University Grant will be dependent on need level (FAFSA filed) and academic performance. A cumulative grade point average of a 2.0 is required for renewal of the University Grant.

Students receiving scholarships may not need to file financial aid applications for renewal of their award if they do not wish to be considered for the need-based financial aid programs listed in the second paragraph.

## NEED-BASED AID APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To apply for the **University Need-Based Grant**, the **Federal Pell Grant**, the **National Science and Mathematics Access to Retain Talent Grant (SMART)**, the **Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education grant (TEACH)**, **Academic Competitiveness Grant (ACG)**, the **Oklahoma Tuition Aid Grant (OTAG)**, the **Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG)**, the **Federal Work Study (FWS)** program, the **Federal Perkins Loan**, and the **Federal Stafford Loan** (subsidized and unsubsidized), the following forms are needed to complete your application (additional forms or data may be required as determined by the Student Financial Services Office):

1. **The 2009/2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**
2. **The 2009/2010 University of Tulsa Financial Aid Application**

The **TU Financial Aid Application** should be completed and returned to the Student Financial Services Office. It is available on our website at [www.utulsa.edu/financialaid](http://www.utulsa.edu/financialaid). If your application is selected for verification, you will be required to submit additional documentation.

To complete your application for financial aid, you must have the FAFSA processed by the government. Students may apply by using **FAFSA on the Web** available on the internet at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>. The homepage of The University of Tulsa — <http://www.utulsa.edu> — has a link available to FAFSA on the Web through the Financial Aid page. If you do not have a personal identification number (PIN), you should request one from the government through the website [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov). Once you receive your PIN from the government, you can use it to file the FAFSA on the Web or to make corrections to your processed FAFSA on the website. If you forget your PIN, you can request it again from this website or you can ask for another PIN. Parents may also request a PIN. Students who apply through FAFSA on the Web and do not have a PIN are required to print the signature page, complete the required signatures, and return it to the government. **Without the required PIN(s) or a signed signature page, your FAFSA will not be processed.** Dependent students without a parental PIN must also print the signature page, complete the signatures, and return it to the government. If you are a transfer student and applied for financial assistance for 2008-2009, you may use the Renewal FAFSA on the Web.

The FAFSA must be completed on the Web. You may print this worksheet to help you complete the FAFSA on the Web. All students must indicate that the information supplied on the FAFSA is to be released to TU (FAFSA question #104) Title IV Institution code 003185
