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The following programs in Education are offered at The University of Tulsa*:

TEACHER EDUCATION

Master of Arts

Students enrolled in the Master of Arts program may select an emphasis in Elementary Education, Secondary Education, or Research and Evaluation.

Master of Teaching Arts

The M.T.A. provides the K-12 and secondary school teacher the opportunity to do graduate study in 18 semester hours of professional education and 18 semester hours in a teaching field. The approved teaching fields are: Art, Biology, English, History, and Mathematics, and Theatre.

Master of Science in Mathematics/Science Education

The University of Tulsa offers a Master of Science degree in Mathematics/Science Education.
