John S. Zink Fellowship for Students with Physical Disabilities

The John S. Zink Fellowship is an endowed fellowship of The University of Tulsa, available to aid T.U. students with physical disabilities. Students already possessing a Bachelor's degree and applying for admission to an advanced degree program are eligible. Preference is given to students in any graduate program. The fellowship amounts are variable and awarded on the basis of need.

To qualify for this fellowship you must be admitted to The University of Tulsa for the Fall semester, in good academic standing, qualify for services provided by The Center for Student Academic Support, and be registered to receive those services. Receipt of the award is contingent upon full-time enrollment at The University of Tulsa.

By February 1 of each academic award year, the John S. Zink Fellow must submit a degree progress report to the Dean of Research and Graduate Studies. This report must be developed in consultation with the student's advisor, and must carry the advisor's endorsement verifying the contents of the report. If no report is received by February 1, the John S. Zink Fellow's award will not be considered for renewal. Renewal of the Fellowship will only be considered if the Fellow has re-applied, using this form, by and has submitted his/her degree progress report by February 1. Renewal is also contingent upon evidence of good academic progress (staying on track in the degree program by passing academic milestones given in departmental specifications within *The University of Tulsa Graduate Bulletin*), and the Fellow remaining in good academic standing.
