

TUwireless Connection Guide – Windows 7

To connect to TUwireless:

Click the network icon in the lower right corner of the screen. Choose TUwireless. **Note** – If you have previously connected to TUwireless, you may need to delete your old connection data. Instructions for that process are provided at the end of this guide.



You may see a screen like the following. If so, choose connect.





You will see a connection in progress dialog, then you may see a small triangle icon over the network icon. This means that you need to authenticate using a web browser.



Launch a web browser. If you already have a browser window open, exit the browser, then re-launch the browser. Do not simply open a new tab or window; the browser must be completely closed, then re-launched.


When the browser opens, you will see this page. Click the link. You will then see a short loading message.






On the login screen, enter your six character utulsa userid and password. This is the same login information you use when logging into your email, or into an on campus computer. If you do not have a


utulsa userid and password, you may register as a guest.




After you have entered your login information, read and accept the agreement. Then check the box and choose Complete Registration.

When you see this screen, you have completed the registration process.




Troubleshooting

Deleting old connection data


From this screen, choose Open Network and Sharing Center
