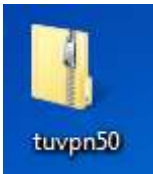


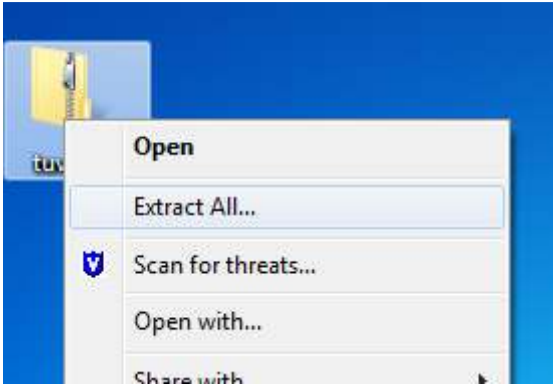

## Cisco VPN Client 5.0

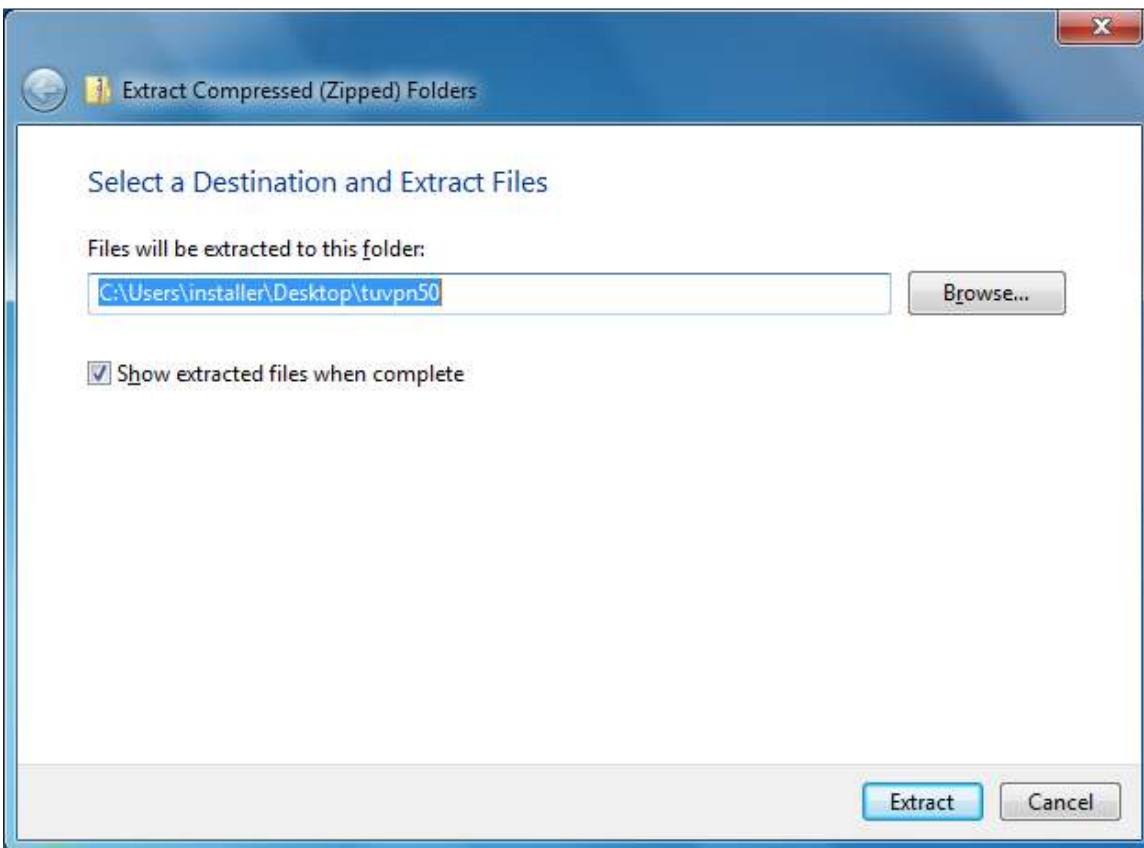
### Setup Example: Windows 7



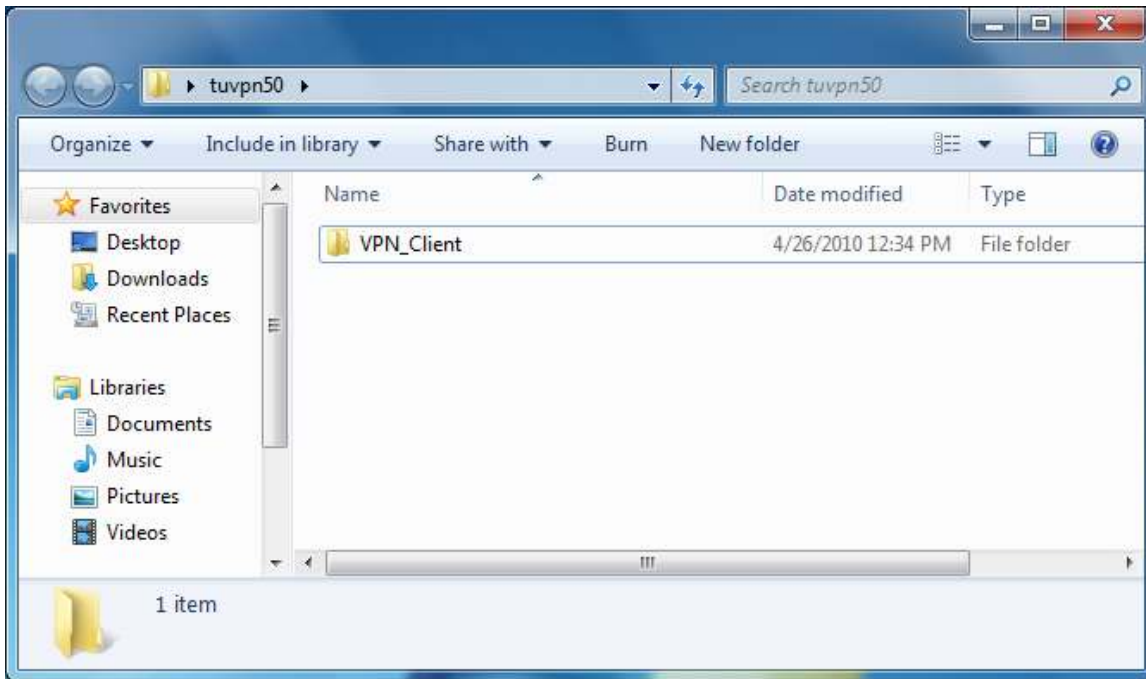
1. Download the latest version of the Cisco VPN Client from the Software Downloads section of MyTU Essentials on the main IT website: <https://www.utulsa.edu/it>



2. Right click and 'Extract All...'



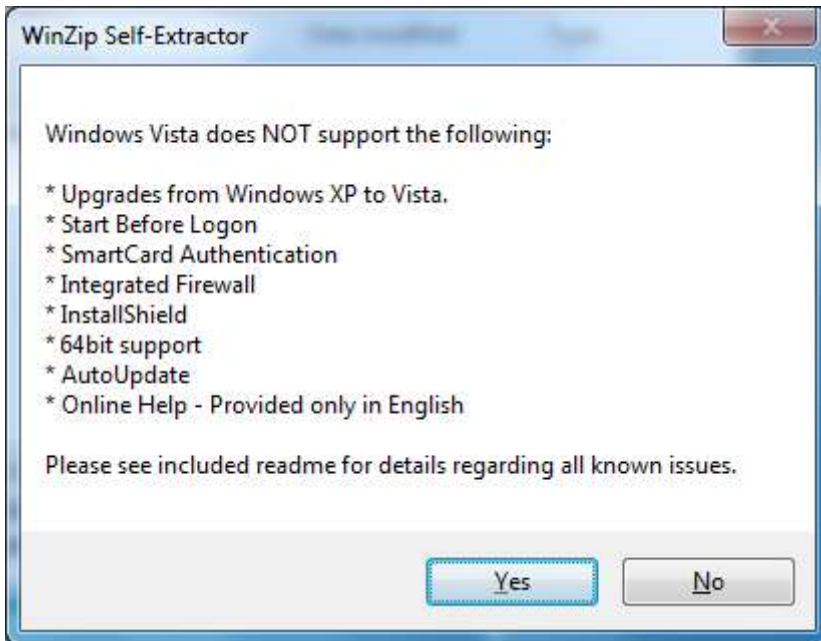
3. Extract the files to a location that you will be able to find easily.



4. Double Click 'VPN\_Client'



5. Double Click the 'MSI installer'



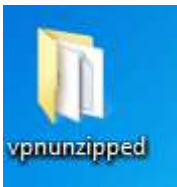
6. Click 'Yes'



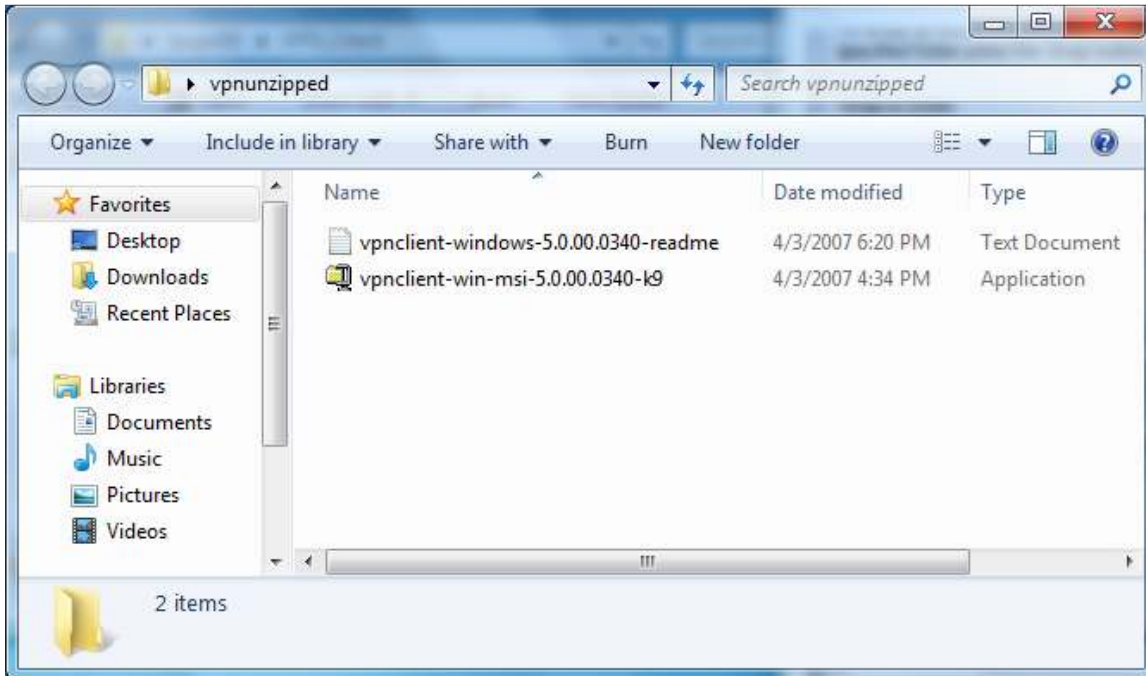
7. Extract the files to a location that you will be able to find easily.



8. Click OK



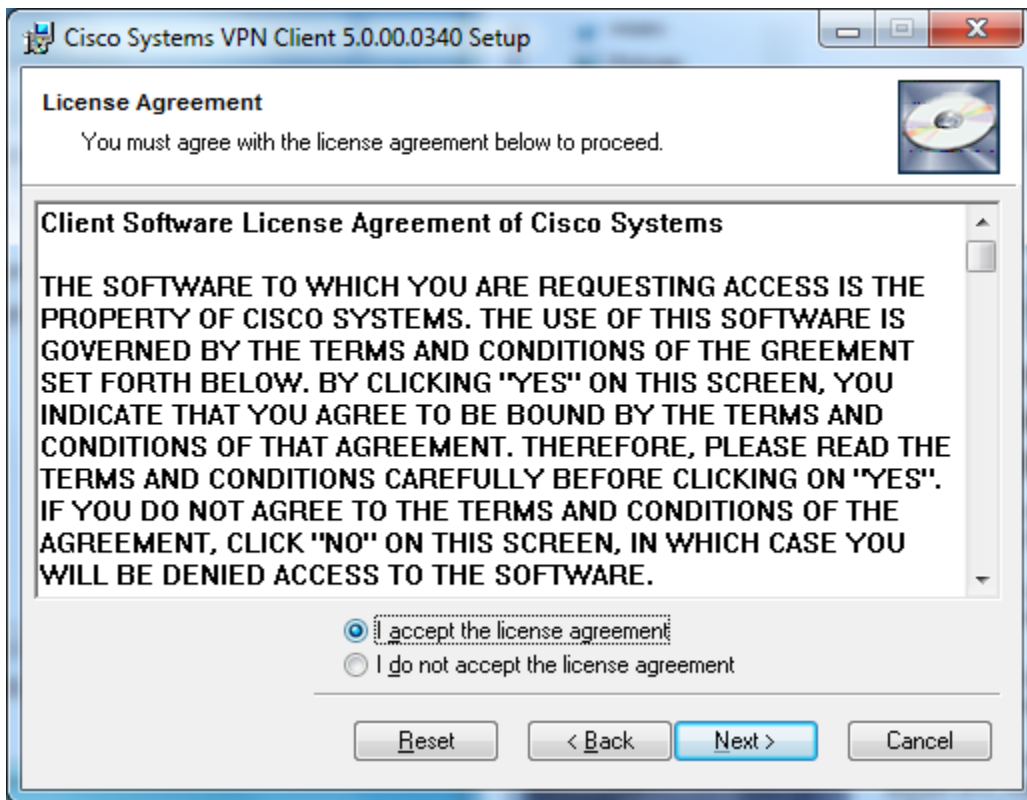
9. Find and Double Click the unzipped folder



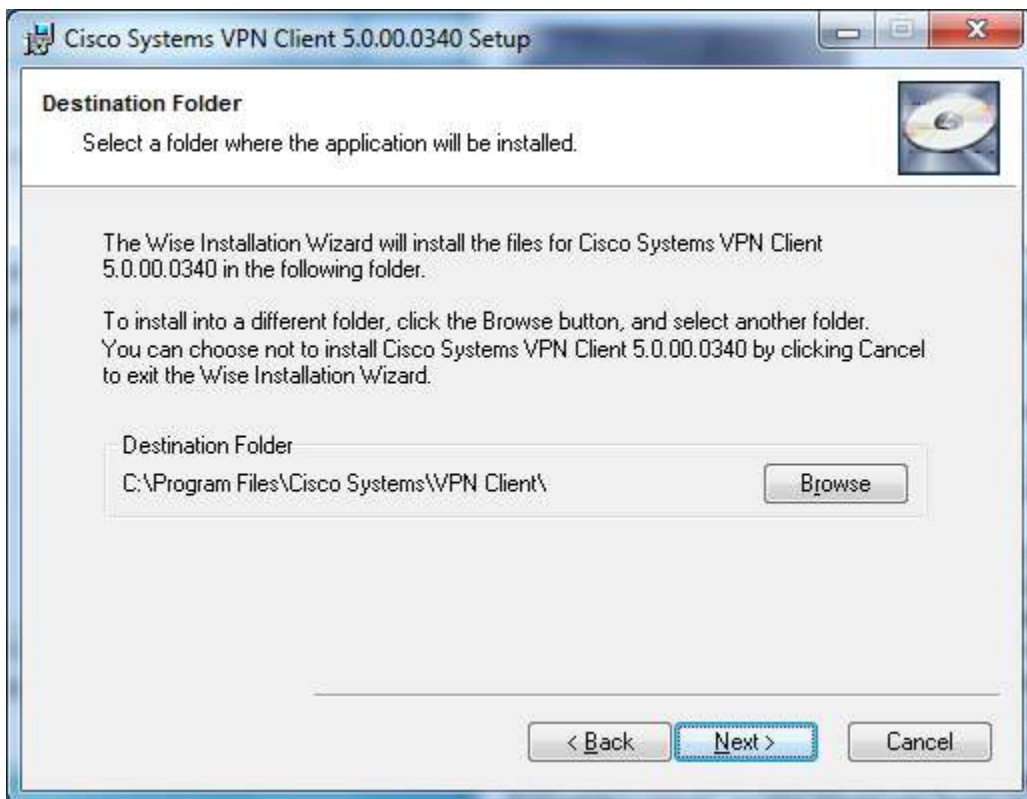
10. Double Click the 'vpnclient-win-msi...'



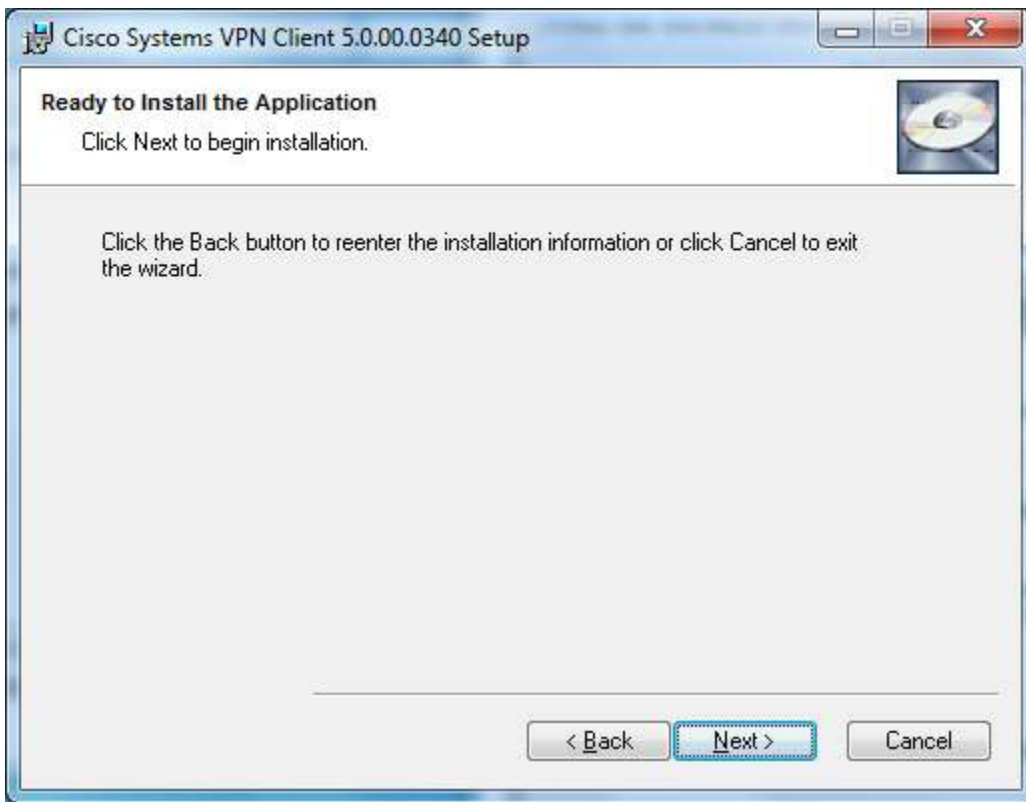
11. Click Next



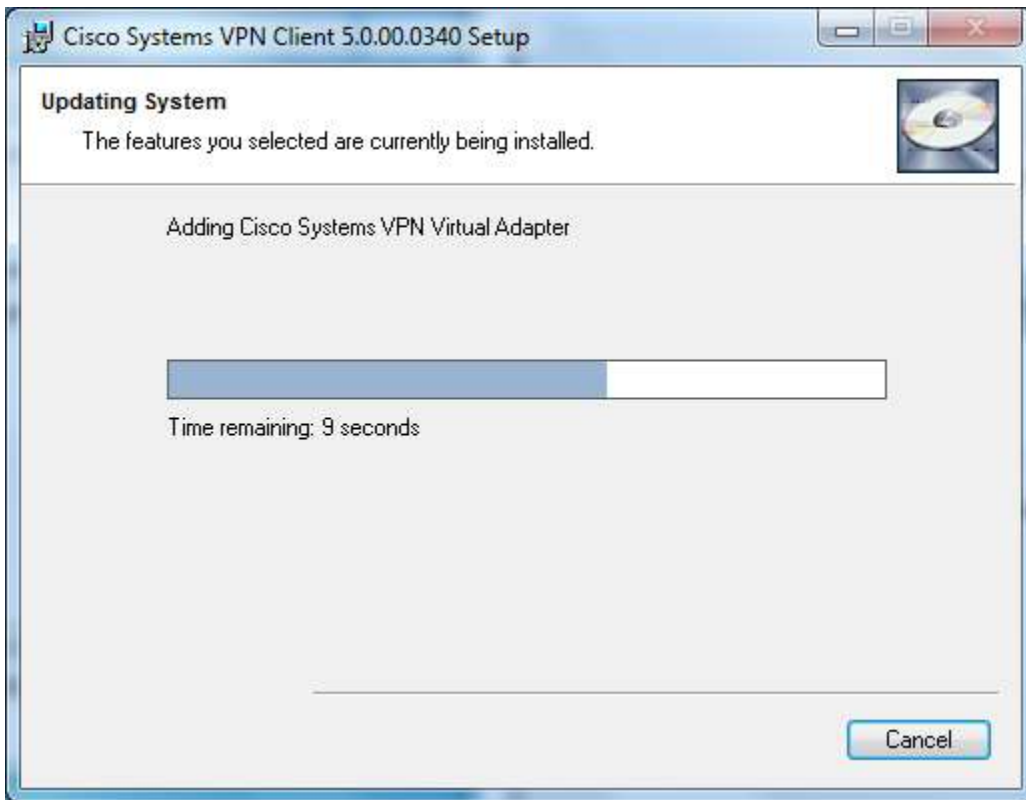
12. Read the entire License Agreement, and click 'Next'.



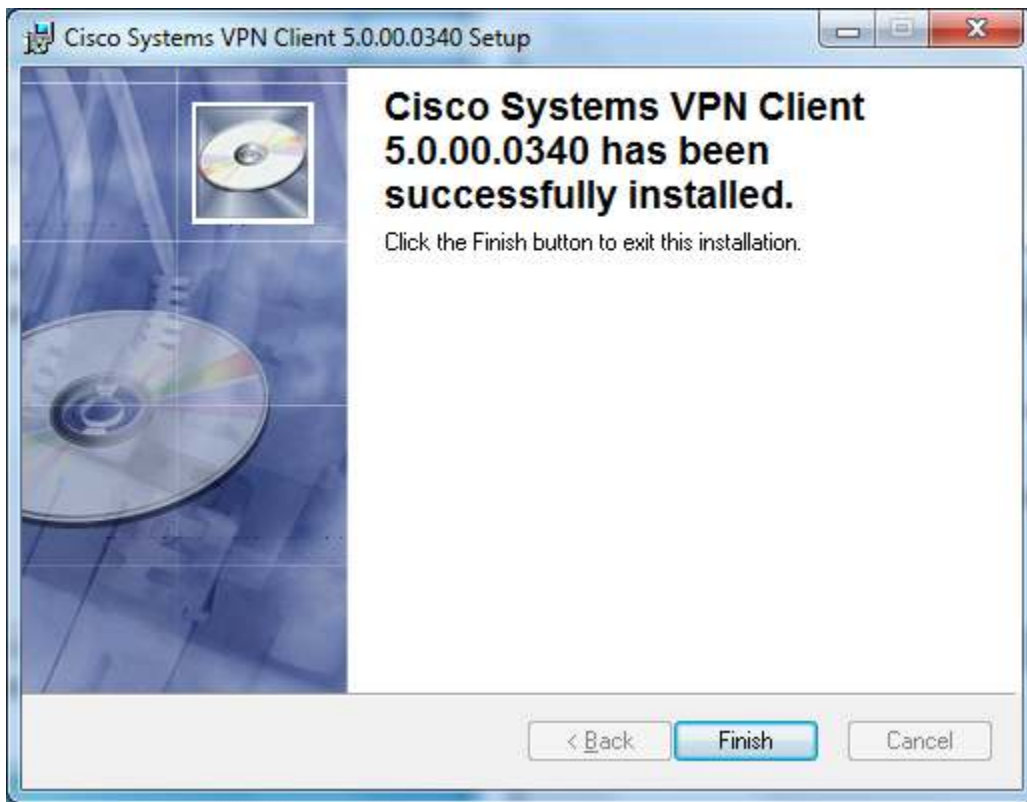
13. Click 'Next'



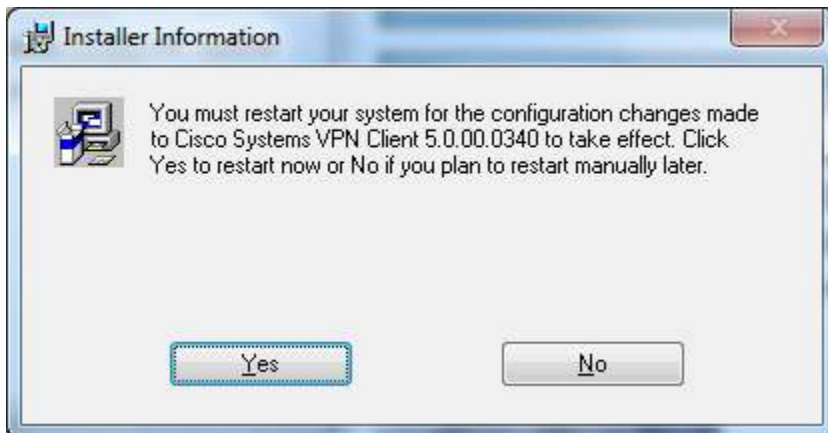
14. Click 'Next'



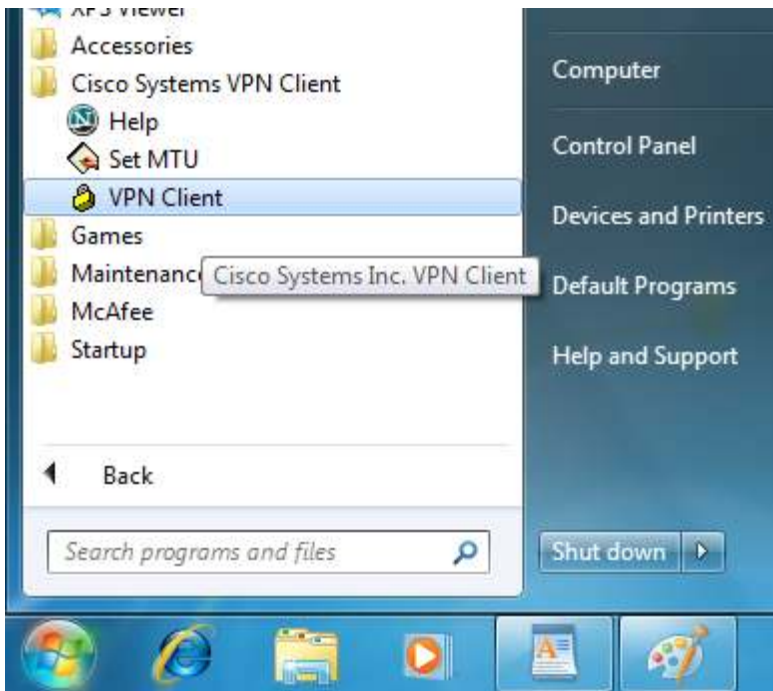
15. Allow the application to install.



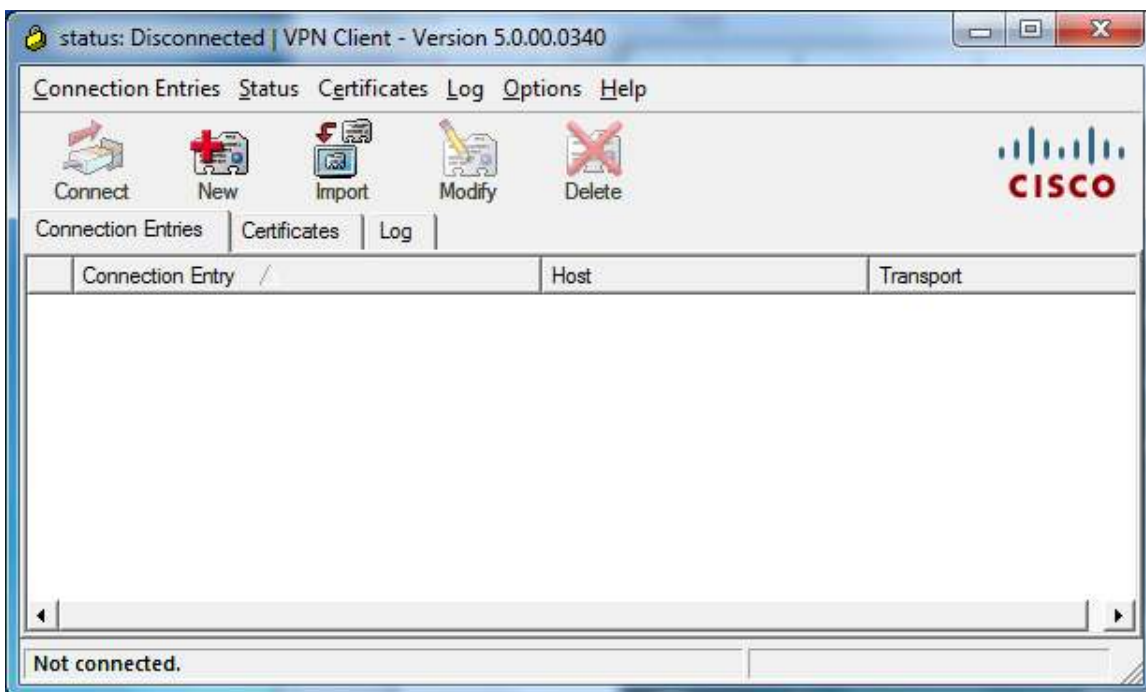
16. Click 'Finish'



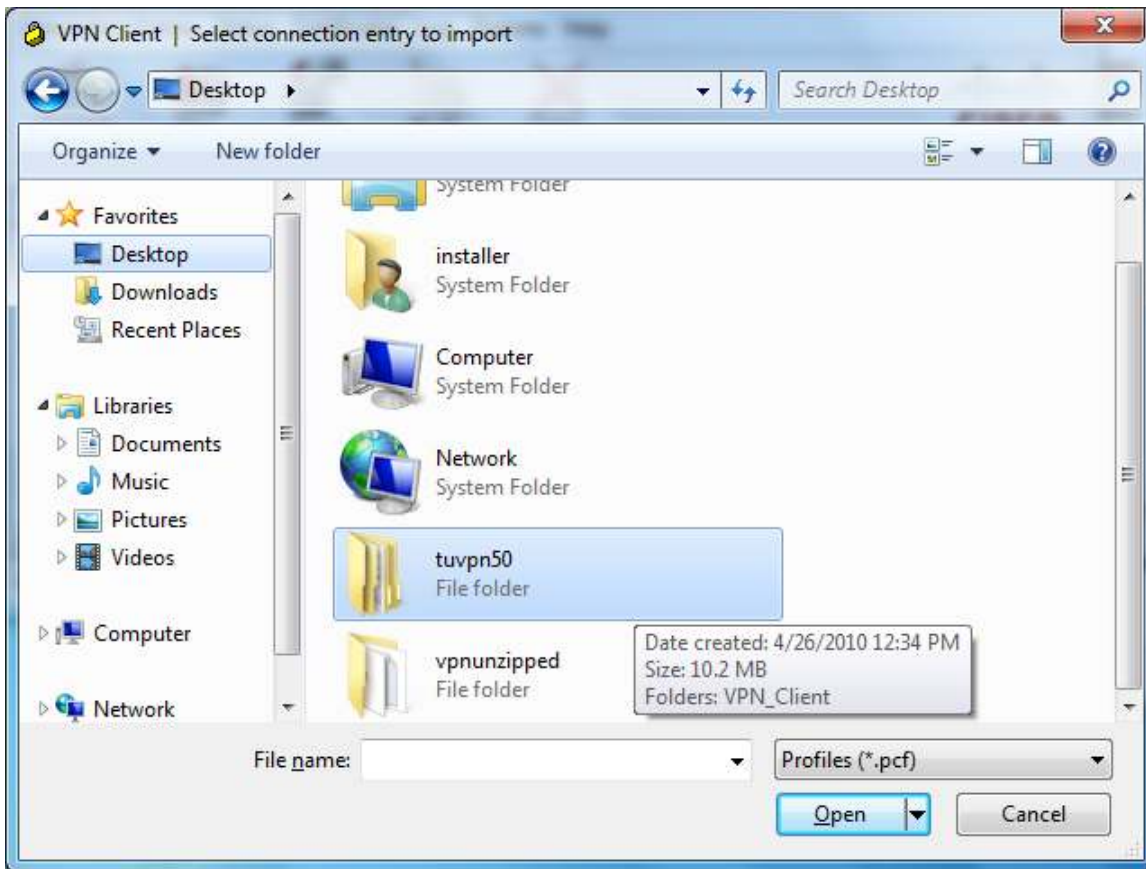
17. Ensure that all other applications are closed, and Select 'yes' to restart the computer.



18. After the restart, find the 'VPN Client' in the Start Menu, and Double Click



19. Select 'Import'



20. Navigate to the original extracted folder.



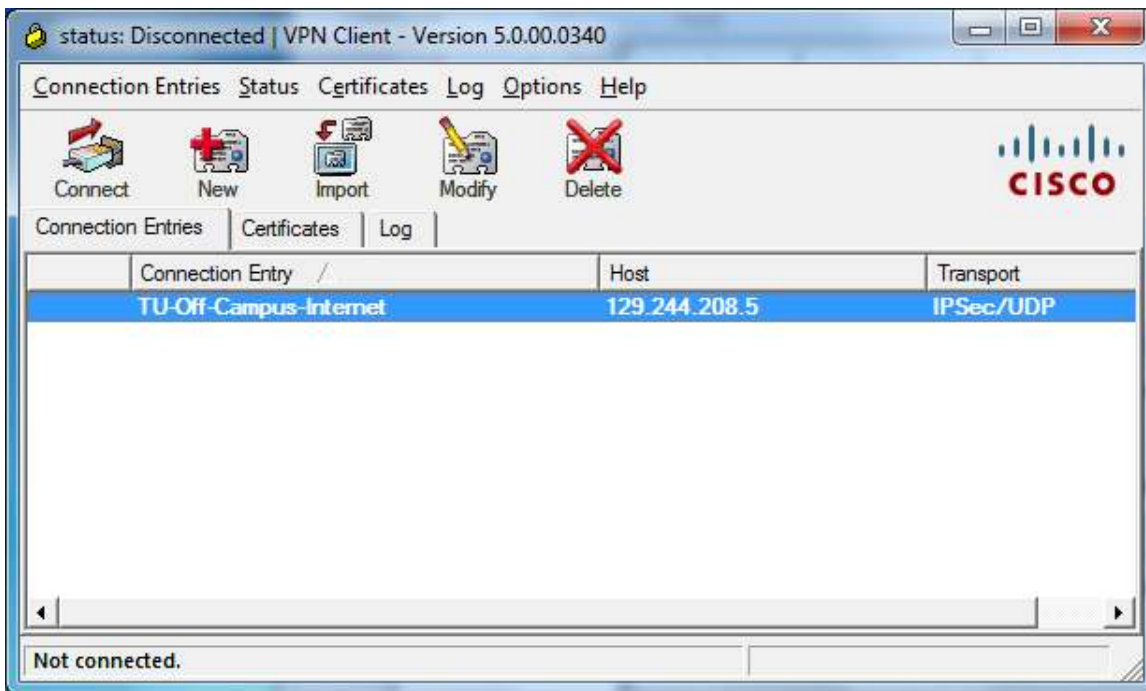
21. Navigate into the 'VPN\_Client' folder.



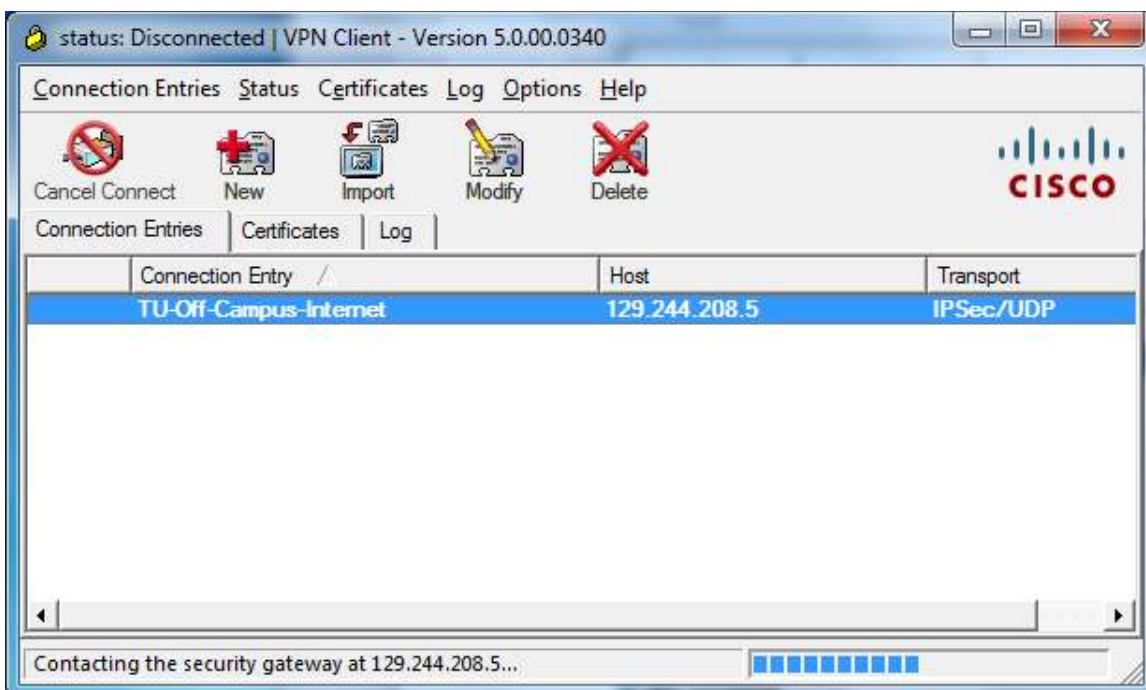
22. Select 'TU-Off-Campus-Internet.pcf' file, Select 'Open'



23. Allow the profile to be imported into the application. Select 'OK'



24. Select the Profile you want to connect to, and select Connect.



25. If you are off campus, the VPN client will connect to campus, and ask you to authenticate with your utulsa username and password.
