

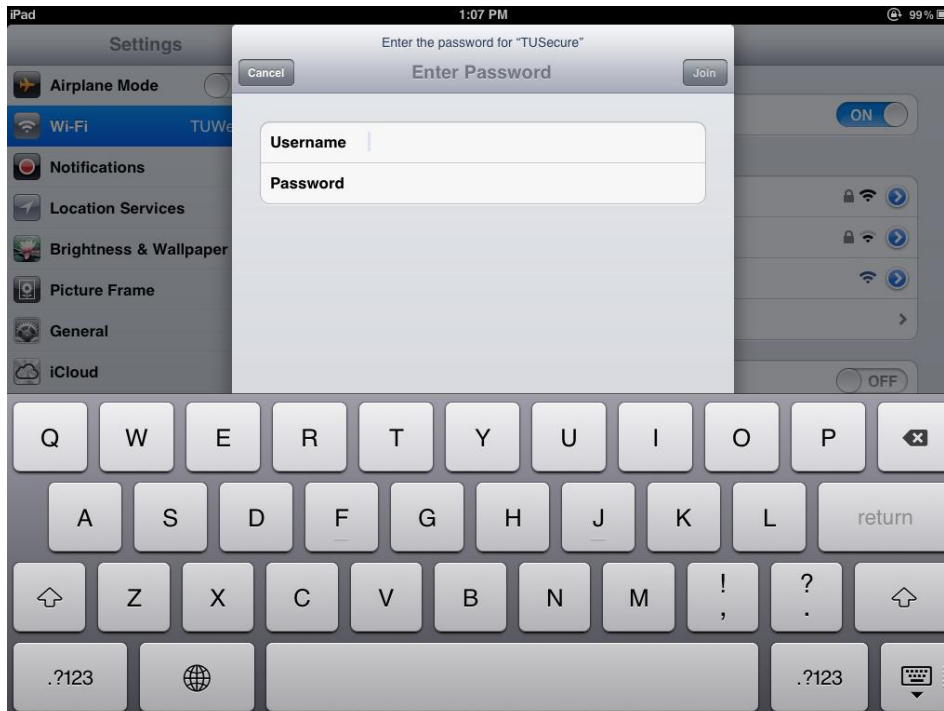
Connecting to TUSecure with iPhone/iPad

Open the Settings app, then choose Wi-Fi




From the Wi-Fi screen, choose TUSecure. You will then be presented with a dialog box. Enter your username and password, then push join.

Note: Your username is not your email address. For example: username – bac213



After you have joined the network, you must open Safari in order to complete the authentication. You will be sent automatically to the network authentication page.

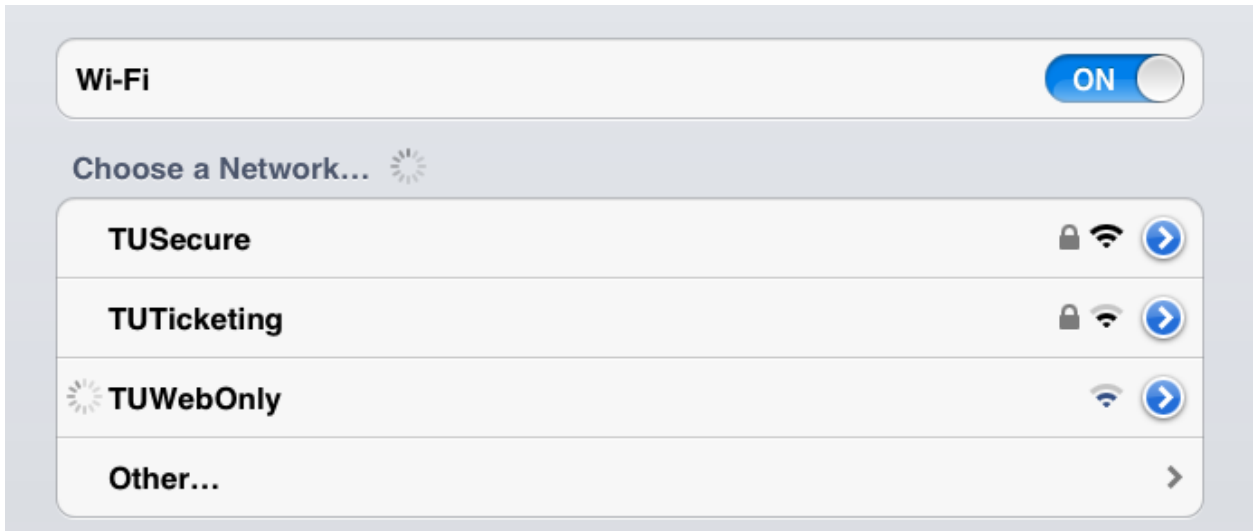
Enter the same username and password that you entered on the previous screen.
