DATES

Our summer program will consist of six one-week sessions as follows:

Session 1: June 3 - 7
Session 2: June 10 - 14
Session 3: June 17 - 21
Session 4: June 24 - 28
Session 5: July 8 - 12
Session 6: July 15 - 19

TIMES

All sessions are from **9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.**
Extended day available for additional fee.

FEES

Before April 15, 2013: \$200 per session
After April 15, 2013: \$225 per session
(Some classes require extra fee - see descriptions for details.)

EXTENDED DAY

7:30 - 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 - 5:30 p.m.
Cost: \$150/Week or \$15/Hour

The extended day program will include activities which are less structured than those in the regular summer classes. These will include outdoor play, games, videos, puzzles, art, and more. Extended day fees are in addition to regular class fees.

REFUNDS

Due to our small class sizes, fees are not refundable. Refunds will be given, however, for any classes which are cancelled because minimum enrollment is not met.

LATE PICK-UP

Pickup is from 3:00 to 3:10 p.m. Any child not picked up by 3:15 p.m. will be sent to the Extended Day Program and charged the hourly rate, with a minimum of \$15.

REGISTRATION CHANGES

A \$25 fee will be charged for any changes made in classes after registration has been received by University School. Changes must be made by the Friday before a session is scheduled to begin. Changes are not allowed once the week's camps have begun.

GRADE AND AGE LEVELS

All class grade levels refer to the grade the student will be entering in the fall of 2013. For Pre-K level, the student must be 4 years old before the start date of the camp session.

LUNCH

Students should bring a complete sack lunch, including a beverage. Lunch will be supervised. **University School has a no-peanut policy; please do not include peanut products in children's lunches.**

BEHAVIOR

Students are expected to have good behavior and follow classroom and school rules at all times. Attendance at our summer program is a privilege, and inappropriate behavior may jeopardize that privilege.

PERSONAL ITEMS

University School is not responsible for personal items brought to camp by students. We prefer that students do not bring personal wireless devices, such as cell phones, e-readers, etc., to camp. If wireless devices are brought to camp, they must be turned off. University School is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of/to personal items brought to camp.

UNIVERSITY SCHOOL STUDENT FEES

Two weeks of Camp Incredible 2013 are included in tuition for University School students (ages 4 and above) who are enrolled for the 2013-2014 academic year. To receive your two included weeks, you must choose your classes and register by April 15, 2013. Any registrations for Camp Incredible received after this date will be subject to the full \$225 fee per class.


